Catherine Coulter

Catherine Coulter is the author of over 84 novels, including 79 New York Times bestsellers, occasionally, after exhaustive prayers, hitting #1. She earned her reputation writing historical romances to pass the time while aboard the ark. She added suspense thrillers to her repertoire – with great success. The Cove, the first book in her bestselling "FBI Suspense Thriller Series" spent nine

weeks on the New York Times list and has to date sold well over 3 million copies. Since then she's written more bestselling thrillers in the FBI series, including The Maze, The Target, The Edge, Riptide, Hemlock Bay, Eleventh Hour, Blindside, Blowout, Point Blank, Double Take, Tailspin, Knockout, Whiplash, Split Second, Backfire, Bombshell, Power Play, Nemesis, Insidious, Enigma, Paradox, and Labyrinth. Her 24th FBI thriller DEADLOCK is set to be released July 28, 2020 in all formats. Coulter also has another suspense thriller series – A Brit in the FBI – co-written with bestselling author JT Ellison. The 6th book in this action-packed series, The Last Second, is available now in all formats.

Ryan McCulloch and Suzanne Colsakos

Ryan McCulloch is the Chief Artist & Designer and Co-Head Writer of Mutasian Entertainment, a children's entertainment company. Since its conception, Ryan has designed the multitude of original characters and critters inhabiting the island of Mutasia. He has illustrated several books in Mutasia's award-winning children's book series, including: Land of Illogical & Utterly Impossible Critters, Figley's New Favorite Food, The Nib Book, and A Nib Christmas. In spring 2017, he



co-authored and illustrated Mutasia's "#1 New Release" on Amazon, Figley's Search for the Perfect Pet, followed by the award winning titles: Figley's Little White Lie in fall 2017 and Figley vs. the Mookling Hat in 2018.

Suzanne Cotsakos is co-founder and Co-Head writer for Mutasia, a children's entertainment company. Suzanne is also the award winning co-founder of Tertiary Productions, an independent film production company, and a main company member of the comedy troupe Duchess Riot, which has been voted "Best Theatre Group" on LA Hotlist for the last four years. The first book that Suzanne co-authored in the Mutasia children's book series, 'Figley's New Favorite Food,' was awarded the "Mom's Choice Gold Seal Award" as well as "Honorable Mention" at the Los Angeles and Pacific Rim Book Festivals. The second book she co-authored, 'Land of Illogical & Utterly Impossible Critters,' also received a "Mom's Choice Gold Seal Award."

Sheldon Siegel
